



Accommodation

At Twin English Centre London we understand the importance of good quality accommodation as part of your language learning experience. Our Accommodation Officers can give you advice on the three options offered by our school: host families, hostels & hotels and shared flats.

Host Families

Living with a British family is the most effective way of improving your English language skills. Speaking to a native English speaker will help you to develop the confidence that is an essential part of language training. Our families are all located close to school and are dedicated to providing a home away from home for our students.

Our Accommodation Officers regularly inspect host families in order to ensure that they are providing clean, welcoming, friendly, safe and comfortable accommodation, which meets Twin Group's high standards. Students are usually accommodated in single rooms and receive breakfast and evening meals. Twin rooms can be requested if you provide details of a named sharer.

Hostels and Hotels/Youth Hostel/ Shared Flats

For students who prefer a more independent lifestyle, we offer a number of carefully selected hotels and residences in London and can provide assistance if you wish to rent your own flat.

Location

Located in the thriving suburb of Lewisham in South East London, the school is just 10 minutes by train from London Bridge and only a five minute DLR tram ride from Greenwich, one of the main tourist attractions in London. In addition, Blackheath, the starting point for the famous London marathon, is a five minute walk from the school. There are also regular bus services to most parts of the city centre and its suburbs.

The school

Twin English Centre London is located on the second floor of a newly refurbished building in central Lewisham, with additional classroom space available nearby for busy periods. Facilities include nine spacious classrooms, a student lounge, a large kitchen with separate eating area and an IT suite. We pride ourselves on providing top quality courses and services at very competitive prices.

Our teachers

All our teachers are native English speakers. They are all qualified professionals, with RSA Cambridge CELTA qualifications or equivalent.

Our teachers are special because they are enthusiastic about teaching, and have the skill to plan effectively for each individual class. They have different backgrounds and interests, which adds to the diversity of topics you will be able to discuss.

The courses

General English Courses

These courses are offered throughout the year and may be started on any Monday for a minimum of one week. Classes with a maximum of 15 students are offered at elementary to advanced levels as follows:

Option 10 - 10 hours per week

Option 15 - 15 hours per week

Option 19 - 19 hours per week

Option 23 - 23 hours per week

Professional English Programme (PEP)

This course is specially designed for students of at least lower intermediate level who wish to combine a course of study with an internship or paid work placement. The programme is accredited by NCFE, a nationally recognised examination body and leads to an intermediate certificate in Employment Skills. The programme is open to both EU and NON EU students.

One to One Courses

Private English Language tuition for general, academic or business purposes.

WorkUK Programmes

Twin Internship Programme

A specialised programme for undergraduates or graduates who are looking to gain valuable relevant practical work experience to support their studies. Placements are unpaid and start weekly.

Part time Internship Programme

A part time option for students that want to attend a Twin English Centre and do work experience at the same time. The internships are general, non-specific placements. The aim is to provide the student with practical experience and enable them to improve their English language skills in the workplace. Placements are unpaid and start weekly.

Graduate Training Programme

The Graduate Training Programme is the highest level of placement we provide, it is aimed at graduates and offers a partly remunerated placement. Placements start weekly.

International Work Trials

International Work Trials is a basic work experience for younger clients (16 plus) who are looking for their first introduction into the working world. Areas such as shops, administration, travel & tourism are offered amongst other industry specific placements.

TeachUK

A combination course which consists of a week of English and a placement in a UK school. Placements are as teaching assistants and are aimed at students that wish to gain valuable work experience within the UK education system.

Anglo Training Programme

Hospitality positions in hospitality companies of all sizes throughout the UK from the Isle of Sky to Cornwall. Positions are from 12 weeks to 1 year. Trainees earn the minimum wage and accommodation and meals are provided. Trainees can also apply for the UCLES certificate. The programme starts weekly and is extremely popular.

Action for Employment Programme

Hospitality positions in hotels, bars, restaurants and clubs in towns and cities around the UK. Trainees earn the minimum wage and can also apply for the UCLES certificate as part of their placement but no accommodation is provided in the programme.
